Main risks

Through the reports of the Spanish Sustainability Observatory (OSE) our goal is to find what are the main sustainability risks facing our cities. Being the main risks of unsustainability that are appreciated the territorial ones (characterized by a low urban density and an excessive increase of the artificial areas) and the socioeconomic ones (economic activity, employment, inefficiency in the use of the housing stock). They highlight the growing sustainability in environmental aspects such as environmental quality, energy consumption and water consumption.
